- Pressure was identified as one of the "Dirty Dozen" the twelve human behaviours that most often lead to accidents.
- While pressure is to be expected in the fast-paced aviation industry, it can directly contribute to safety incidents by interfering with our ability to complete tasks correctly.
- One of the most common sources of pressure is ourselves.

What to do if you're under pressure

- Say something it's important to express your concerns.
- You may need to be assertive learn to speak up when safety is on the line
- Ask for help extra hands can relieve some of the pressure to complete a task or meet a timeline
- Take a moment pause to catch your breath and revisit your standard operating and safety procedures
