#### 2.2 Toronto Pearson Street Fest

R. Connelly noted on Saturday September 15, 2012, Toronto Pearson will be holding their 2<sup>nd</sup> annual Street Festival. Guests will be able to enjoy airside tours, a tour of a FedEx cargo plane and also get up-close viewings of Air Canada Jazz, and KLM aircraft. The event will also have demonstrations and displays by the GTAA's airfield maintenance, environment, noise, fire and emergency services, canine and wildlife controls. Guests will also get to enjoy delicious food and watch groups from neighbouring communities perform live shows onstage.

## 2.3 T3 Enhancement Program

- T. Lennox highlighted that, with a successful global hub strategy, Toronto Pearson must examine available terminal capacity. The GTAA will be investing four hundred million dollars in revitalizing Terminal 3 to:
  - Create capacity for, and enable, growth.
  - Enhance guest experience in terminals.
  - Address regulatory requirements.
  - Improve Toronto Pearson's competitiveness.
- Terminal 3 opened 1991; handled 11 million passengers in 2011.
- Gating and sector enhancements will be made in 2015-2016.
- Enhancements to the terminal building would include:
  - Additional transborder screening.
  - Consolidated Canada customs facility for arrivals & connections.
  - Expanded baggage hall.
- Increased retail and food/beverage beyond security
- B. Clark inquired when the annual flights at Toronto Pearson reach fifty million passengers, will Toronto Pearson build an airport in Pickering. T. Lennox responded it is a decision that Transport Canada would have to make.

### Item Details

• R. Unterman inquired if the GTAA will do outreach to business travellers prior to the major construction of T3. T. Lennox responded in the positive and noted that the public will be notified in the beginning phases of construction.

#### 3.2 T3 Terminal Tour

- R. Cruickshank, Community Engagement Officer provided a tour of T3 followed by onboard tour of the Emirates 380 aircraft.
