Operational Continuity During the Pandemic

Essential service designation

Recognition of full spectrum of domestic supply chain operations

- Final-mile package delivery operations, hub operations, warehouses, customs brokerage operations, UPS Stores.
- Regional Public Health Orders (Section 22 Orders) –possible closure of transportation/critical infrastructure.







Essential service designation

Cross-border operational continuity

- Air cargo operations, pilots and crew.
- Cross-border trucking operations.
- Importance of operational continuity as Canadian border restrictions evolve e.g. vaccine requirements for federally regulated employees, international crew.







Expanding domestic network capacity during lockdowns

Adapting to changing delivery needs

- Shift towards more residential deliveries during lockdowns as e-commerce sales accelerated.
- Need for more employees, vehicles, aircraft and container space.
- Need for construction continuity during lockdowns to enable additional network capacity.





A year of unprecedented pandemic-driven decline in demand and capacity








